

FLOWER TALE EARRINGS

Free Beading Tutorial

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PROJECT LEVEL Beginner to Intermediate

MATERIALS 12 bronze opaque 6mm Czech glass pearl round beads 2 gr. gold lustered dark topaz Japanese 11/0 seed beads (Toho 459) Size B gold beading thread 2 bronze earring hooks


TOOLS Size 10 beading needle Scissors

FINISHED SIZE Diameter – 3 cm (1.18 inches) (without earring hooks)

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. Cut about 90 cm (36 inches) of thread and pass it through the needle hole. Pick six groups of one 11/0 seed bead and one 6 mm round bead.
Join the beads into a ring and secure with two square knots. Leave a tail of about 10 cm (4 inches).
Step 2. The working thread should be right before the 6 mm round bead. Pick seven 11/0 seed beads, skip the 6 mm round bead and pass the needle through the next 11/0 seed bead added in the previous round.

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
